



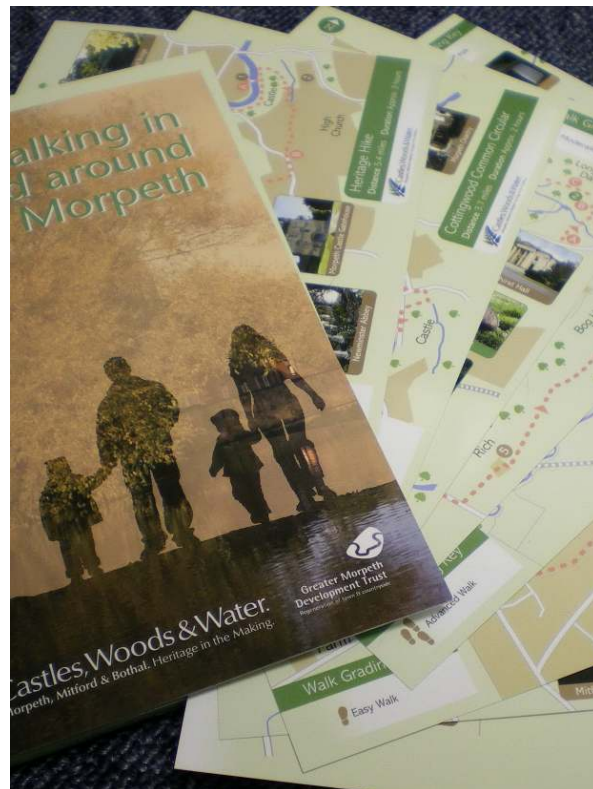
## Greater Morpeth Development Trust Walking Maps



Over the last two years the trust has been working on a folder of walking maps. The pack includes all of your favourite walks in and around Morpeth. The maps highlight area of interest (heritage and environment) and give step by step walking guidelines and include pictures of various attractions along the way

The maps were developed by the Environment and the Heritage interest group and include all the walks that have featured in the annual walking festival. There are fifteen maps in total included in the folder (see below for list of walks):
